We write to express our opposition to the demand that the taxpayers of New Jersey pay the federal government \$271 million because the Access to the Region's Core (ARC) project was cancelled. While some of us may differ on whether or not the ARC project should have been cancelled, we are united in our effort to protect New Jersey taxpayers from harm.


We are deeply concerned that forcing New Jersey to pay these funds will undermine efforts for a new Trans-Hudson tunnel, and require the State to postpone or cancel other essential, job-creating transit projects throughout the State. This will only exacerbate the State's transportation and economic challenges, and impose an unfair burden on taxpayers in New Jersey.


As you know, Amtrak is now preparing to begin preliminary engineering and design of the proposed "Gateway" tunnel, which could utilize some of the design and data developed for ARC. Use of these resources for the proposed Gateway project, or the possible extension of the New York City No. 7 Subway into New Jersey, has the potential to lower some of the costs and expedite the delivery of these initiatives.




